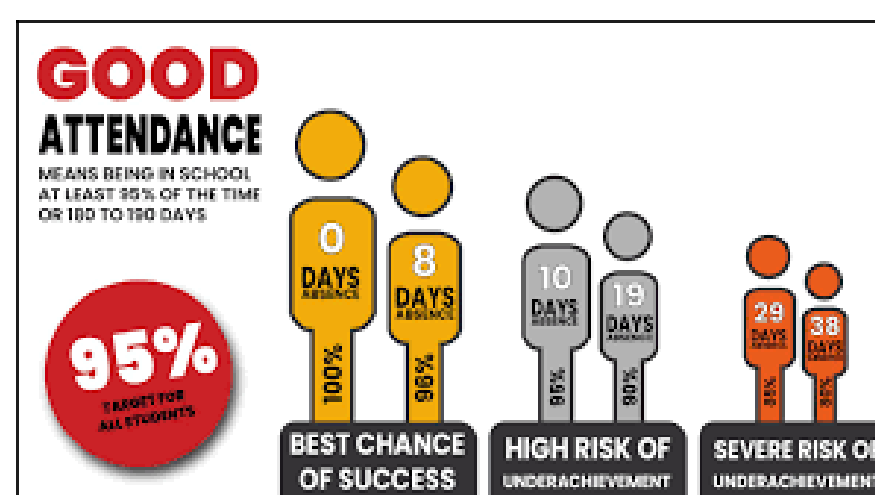
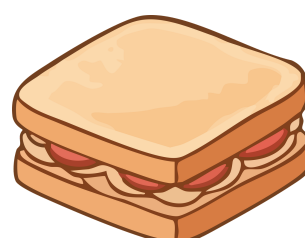

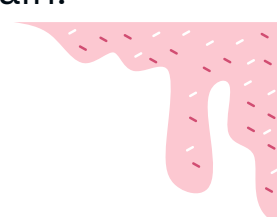
Father's Day Breakfast

EYFS are alive!

This week, EYFS have embraced the warm weather and thoroughly enjoyed exploring outdoors. The children have used their imaginations to create sandy scenes, get messy in the mud kitchen, and care for the babies by washing them in soapy suds. They have also loved making coloured water potions and improvising their own paddling pools for their feet.

We have continued our Traditional Tales topic and, having explored The Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood, and Jack and the Beanstalk, it was the turn of The Gingerbread Man. We read the story, sequenced the key events, and learned new vocabulary. The children also noticed how stories can change over time, exploring three different versions this week.

In maths, we have started using Rekenreks to help us add two numbers, impressing many staff with our confidence and knowledge. Next week, we will explore Goldilocks and the Three Bears and take part in our Jump Up Day, where we experience being in Year 1 – we will certainly miss you for the day!

It's a fantastic tool that really helps develop fluency and confidence with number and multiplication facts. If you are having any trouble logging in, please speak to your child's class teacher for support.

Year 3

Runner Bean Growing Project

This week, the children began an exciting new science investigation. Each child placed a runner bean seed onto a damp paper towel, sealed it inside a zip-lock bag, and attached it to the classroom window. They thoroughly enjoyed setting up their mini growing stations and are now eager to observe what happens next. Over the coming days and weeks, the children will monitor any changes, record their observations, and write about the growth of their bean plants as part of their ongoing learning in science.
