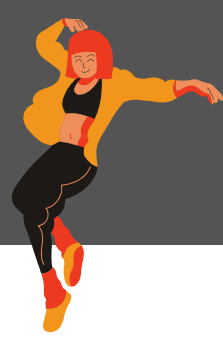

Top 3 classes who have earned the most coins collectively on TTRS.

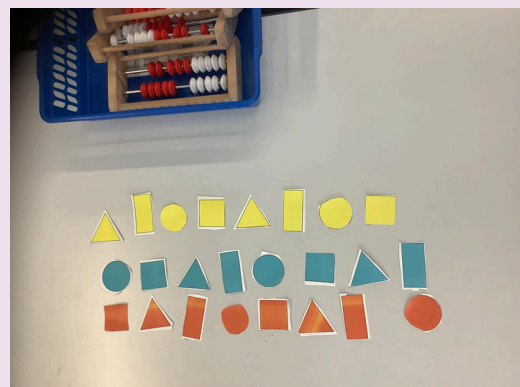

It's a fantastic tool that really helps develop fluency and confidence with number and multiplication facts. If you are having any trouble logging in, please speak to your child's class teacher for support.

Maths

This week, we've been on the move in Maths! The children explored positional language by practising forwards, backwards, left and right. We also had lots of fun with turns, learning about clockwise and anticlockwise, including half (½) and quarter (¼) turns. To finish, we used 2D shapes to create exciting repeating patterns and sequences!



R.E.

In R.E., we explored the story of the Ten Plagues of Ancient Egypt. The children worked hard to put the events in the correct order and discussed why these events happened. We showed great thinking and curiosity.



Science

Science was full of wonder this week! The children carried out a fun experiment drawing pictures on plates with whiteboard pens. When water was added, they were amazed to see their drawings float and change shape. Lots of "wow" moments!



English

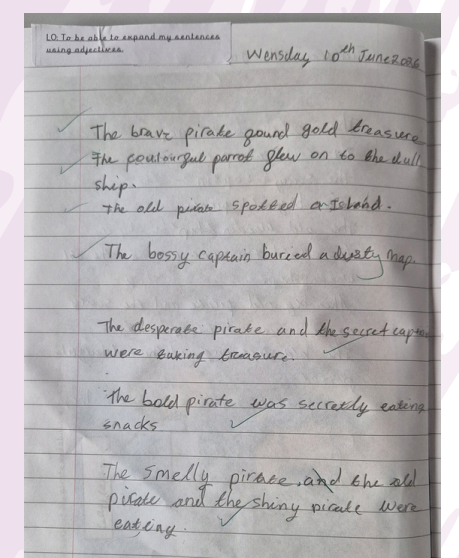

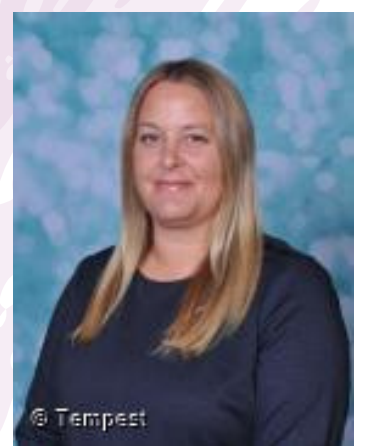


Please can we ask,, that when dropping off/picking up your child, parents be mindful of the language they use. No swearing please.
