Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2 Autumn trip to Ferry Meadows - Friday 3rd October

As part of our topic '**Seaside Sensation**' in the Autumn Term we would like to take the children to Ferry Meadows to get a real appreciation of living and non-living things.

This trip will take place on **Friday 3rd October** and we would ask that children arrive at school at normal time for morning registration, we plan to leave school at 9.30am. We will be travelling by coach and the children will be accompanied by members of our staff and volunteers.

The children will have the opportunity to visit Ferry Meadows visitor centre in the morning, explore the vast grounds in the afternoon. Children will have a educational experience outside of the classroom and be able to explore natural features in the country park.

The return coach will leave Ferry Meadows at 2.00pm, meaning we should return to school at **2.30pm** (traffic dependent).

We would like the children to wear their **school P.E uniform, suitable shoes** (trainers) and bring weather appropriate clothing should the weather be rainy or in the case of a heat wave, most definitely including raincoat! We will provide a school packed lunch, although a **named water bottle** will be required for the day. If you prefer please feel free to send your child with a home packed lunch. Children do not need to bring their school bag or any bag for this trip.

The cost of this trip is **£11.50** per child, which includes the cost of transport, educational experience and resources used at Ferry meadows. No other spending money will be necessary. Please can you pay your contribution by **Friday 26th September 2025** via Magic Booking.

The 1988 Education Act requires school to ask parents to contribute voluntarily to school visits. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received the trip may have to be cancelled. Please speak to a member of the office team, or your child's class teacher if you are likely to find this difficult.
