Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 3 Cathedral Trip – Friday 13th February

On Friday 13th February we would like to take your Year 3 child to Peterborough Cathedral as part of our next RE unit. This will be an exciting morning filled with fun and learning on a Faith, Worship and Belief workshop. On the trip, students will explore key Christian beliefs through hands-on activities around the Cathedral.

They will:

- Learn about baptism at the font and discuss its meaning.
- Look at different cross designs and what they show about Jesus.
- Discover how Christians use the Bible in daily life.
- Try on priestly robes and learn what each one represents.
- Explore the altar and the symbolic objects used in the Eucharist.

Departure from school will be at 9:45am and we aim to return at approximately 11:45pm. Your child will need to wear their school uniform. We will be back in time for lunch so please order your child's lunch as normal or send your child to school with their packed lunch and they will eat in school at their normal lunchtime at 12:30pm.

The cost for this visit will be £7.85 per child. This includes entrance to the Cathedral, activities and the coach. You are able to make this payment using your MagicBooking account.

The 1988 Education Act requires school to ask parents to contribute voluntarily to school visits. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received the trip may have to be cancelled. Please speak to a member of the office team, or your child's class teacher if you are likely to find this difficult.
