At St. Michael's Church School, we wish to make a positive difference through maths, but not as you know it! We plan to take part again in **NSPCC Number Day** on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026.

We want to help support the National Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children so that every child has a safe and happy childhood. To celebrate this worthwhile cause, we are asking children to come to school wearing 'digits' for the day for a small donation.

- Wearing a digit on a sports shirt. i.e. Kane number 10
- I'm 4 years old, so come to school wearing 4 different colours
- Wearing an 'I am 6 badge.'
- I'm in Year 6, so I will wear 6 different coloured clothes.
- Fancy dress – digit 1 to 9

Our church school family and wider community can use maths to help raise money for this charity in a fun, but creative way.

- £4 could connect one child to Childline
- £400 could connect 100 children to Childline
- £1200 could connect 300 children to ChildLine.

By taking part in this fun day, we aim for our children to understand how the NSPCC helps children and young people whilst raising money and promoting a 'positive can do' attitude to maths. In addition, we aim to show children how math's links to the wider the world and is beyond numbers.
