Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2 Summer Trip to Hunstanton - Friday 3rd July

As part of our topic '**Seaside Sensation**' in the Summer Term we would like to take the children to Hunstanton to get a real appreciation of life in a seaside town and experience everything linked to a seaside visit.

This trip will take place on **Friday 3rd July** and we would ask that children arrive at school at **8:40am**, ready for a prompt departure at 9.15am. We will be travelling by coach and the children will be accompanied by members of our staff and volunteers.

The children will have the opportunity to visit The Sealife Centre in the morning, explore the seaside town and experience the sand and sea beneath their toes whilst exploring the beach, rockpools and paddling in the sea. They will also enjoy a pre-ordered ice cream on the beach.

The return coach will leave Hunstanton at 3.30pm, meaning we should return to school for the later time of **5.00pm** (traffic dependent).

We would like the children to wear their **school uniform, suitable shoes** (trainers) and bring weather appropriate clothing should the weather be rainy or in the case of a heat wave, most definitely including sun lotion and a hat! We will provide a school packed lunch, although a **named water bottle** will be required for the day. If you prefer please feel free to send your child with a home packed lunch.

Please can we request that your child brings a **small suitable backpack** to carry their water bottle, sun lotion and some entertainment for the coach journey (top trump cards, books, drawing pad, wordsearch, etc - NO electronic devices please!)

You may also want to provide your child with a healthy snack for them to enjoy mid-afternoon, before they set off on the coach back home. Please make sure this is something that will not ruin in warm weather.

The cost of this trip is **£23.75** per child, which includes the cost of transport, entrance to the Sealife Centre and an ice cream whilst we are there. No other spending money will be necessary. Please can you pay your contribution by **Friday 12th June 2026** via Magic Booking.

The 1988 Education Act requires school to ask parents to contribute voluntarily to school visits. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received the trip may have to be cancelled. Please speak to a member of the office team, or your child's class teacher if you are likely to find this difficult. As always, if you would like to discuss any aspect of this visit, please do not hesitate to speak to us.
