EYFS Role Play Village Enrichment Visit – Friday 2nd October

We are very excited to announce the first enrichment experience for your EYFS children as they begin school. On **Friday 2nd October**, we will be welcoming PuddleJump Lane Role Play experience, to enhance our first topic where we explore 'People around us that help'.

During this immersive play experience, children will have the opportunity to be nurses, doctors, vets, builders, police officers, fire fighters, hairdressers, shop assistants and more. They can get involved with costumes, toys and play equipment.

This role play village will allow the children to share their imaginative and creative play, but also share their language skills with us, develop their social and emotional skills and practice their fine and gross motor skills.

Children will go to the hall in groups where the role play village will be set up and spend part of the day immersed in the role play village there. The school day times will remain as normal and children do not need to bring in anything specific. Normal uniform is to be worn on this day.

To allow this immersive play experience to be able to come to St Michael's, for each child we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£4.15**. Please can you make your contribution using your Magic Booking account, no later than **Friday 25th September 2026**.

The 1988 Education Act requires school to ask parents to contribute voluntarily to school visits and experiences.
