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Year 5/6 Trip to Bletchley Park – Tuesday 17th November 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are thrilled to announce an exciting educational visit for Years 5 and 6 to Bletchley Park on **Tuesday 17th November 2026**, as part of our topic on World War Two.

Bletchley Park is a historic site in Buckinghamshire that played a vital role during World War II. It was the home of Britain's Codebreakers, including the famous mathematician Alan Turing, who helped decipher secret enemy messages. During the visit, pupils will have the opportunity to explore the site, learn about its fascinating history, and discover how the work carried out at Bletchley Park helped shape the course of the war.

Trip Details:

- **Departure:** Coach leaves school at **9.15am**.
- **Return:** Coach departs Bletchley Park at **3.15pm**, aiming to be back at school by **4.40pm** (subject to traffic). We will keep you updated throughout the day.

Cost:

The cost of the trip is **£30.00**, which covers transport. Payment should be made via **Magic Booking** by **Tuesday 17th November**.

What to Bring:

- A packed lunch and water bottle
- Spending money (optional – we recommend no more than £10)
- A small backpack to carry belongings

A more detailed letter with final arrangements will be sent out closer to the time.

This promises to be a fantastic day of discovery, and we're confident it will be one of the highlights of the year for our Year 5 and 6 pupils!
